The page limit restriction of 20 pages has been deleted from the RFQ.

Questions that were received for clarification:

1. Per the RFQ, proposals shall not exceed 20 pages. With the Addendum #1 to include a full SF330 vs only Part I & Part II, is the full SF330 considered part of the page limit count of 20 pages? **20 page count removed from the RFQ**
2. Are copies of the required professional licenses and certifications of the proposer and its sub-consultant(s) considered part of the maximum page count? **20 page count removed from the RFQ**
3. If the required professional licenses and certifications are part of the maximum page count, may these items be reduced in size to fit multiple licenses on one page? **20 page count removed from the RFQ**
4. Does the Authority consider a firm's State of Florida MBE or M/WBE status acceptable for DBE status for partial scoring for this item? **Go to www.flypgd.com to see the Authority's DBE Plan**
5. Per the RFQ, Section 1.0 states: "up to three (3) qualified firms will be selected and will serve as an extension of the staff for a myriad of small, medium, and large architectural, engineering, and projects/tasks." Does the Authority intend to select up to three (3) firms for each discipline as defined as Professional Services by FS 287.055? (ie: architect, surveying, engineering, etc) **We will select three qualified firms**
6. Are the required forms (Attachment A, B, C) provided by the Authority included in the total page count? **20 page count removed from the RFQ**

Question(s) that were received for clarification:

1. Does the Authority want to see what services/discipline the proposing Prime firm can provide on it's on, or does the Authority want to see a full team (including sub-consultants) that can perform all the potential projects listed? If a full team, then the submittal team could be comprised of an infinity of subs. **Yes**
